

The SLVCA has launched an aggressive educational campaign aimed at informing the public of the peril posed by natural gas drilling to the San Luis Valley and to the Baca National Wildlife Refuge, and of the actions concerned citizens can take to protect themselves, their environment, and their way of life.

***We are pledged to:***

- *Educate the community* on the potential adverse impacts of oil and gas exploration to human health and safety, wildlife, water, air, vegetation, and sensitive habitats.
- *Work with Saguache County Commissioners and the local planning commissions* to enact oil/gas regulations that will adequately protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Saguache County, our environment and wildlife.
- *Participate with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission* in the development of new rules and regulations regarding how oil and gas well permits are issued in the state.
- *Help the community to participate fully in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process* to ensure that USFWS identifies significant impacts associated with the proposed drilling activities and conducts a full Environment Impact Study.
- *Lobby for on-the-ground inspectors* during any drilling or completion processes on behalf of the community.
- *Gain the support of state and federal officials* to do everything they can to protect our environment and way of life.
- *Conduct outreach activities* throughout the region to enlarge our voice and support for protection of the Baca NWR and the SLV.
- *Identify the cultural resources* found on the Baca Ranch and pursue appropriate actions to protect them.
- *Pursue a strategy for acquiring the mineral rights* under the Baca Grande subdivision and the Baca NWR.
